

# Journald

output since booting:

```
journalctl -b
```

Follow:

```
journalctl -f
```

Keep an eye on sshd service:

```
journalctl -b -f -l -u sshd
```

Examples:

```
journalctl -b --system
```

```
journalctl -b --user
```

```
journalctl --since=yesterday
```

```
journalctl -b _PID=1
```

```
journalctl -b _UID=1001
```

```
journalctl -b /usr/bin/sudo
```

```
journalctl KERNEL_DEVICE=+scsi:0:0:0:0
```

```
-x -> extra info
```

To monitor the output of dmesg:

```
# journalctl -kf
```

or

```
# dmesg -wH
```
