

# Snapper PvdM

Show configs:

```
# snapper list-configs
```

Create snapshot:

```
# snapper -c home create --description "/home snapshot"
```

View snapshots:

```
# snapper -c home ls
```

## delete snapper config

```
# snapper -c home delete-config
```

If that does not work:

- remove /home from fstab
- reboot and log in as root

```
• cd {vol}/.snapshots (b.v. /home/.snapshots)
```

```
• # for i in $(ls -l); do btrfs property set -ts $i/snapshot/ ro false; done
```

```
• # rm -rf *
```

```
• # ..
```

```
• # rmdir .snapshots
```
