

# Fix suspend to RAM on a HP8530p EliteBook on OpenSUSE 11.2

Suspend to disk works out of the box, but for suspend to ram you need to modify `/usr/lib/hal/scripts/linux/hal-system-power-suspend-linux`:

change:

```
#We only support pm-utils
if [ -x "/usr/sbin/pm-suspend" ] ; then
    export NUM_SECONDS_TO_SLEEP=$seconds_to_sleep
    /usr/sbin/pm-suspend $QUIRKS
    RET=$?
else
    # TODO: add support
    unsupported
fi
```

to:

```
# We only support pm-utils
# if [ -x "/usr/sbin/pm-suspend" ] ; then
#     export NUM_SECONDS_TO_SLEEP=$seconds_to_sleep
#     /usr/sbin/pm-suspend $QUIRKS
#     RET=$?
# else
#     # TODO: add support
#     unsupported
# fi
/usr/sbin/s2ram -f -p -s
```

- Or upgrade to openSUSE 11.3, for in this version the suspend and hibernate works flawlessly. Also the video (with radeon driver) is perfect.
